




**Terms and conditions of authorisation.**

3. ~~The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer other side transport~~ the Biomedical waste without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
5. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility and such other terms conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
